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HOUSE RULES & RESIDENT AGREEMENT

Crestridge Recovery House is a structured, peer-supported, drug-free and alcohol-free recovery residence for men committed to sobriety. These rules exist to protect the safety, dignity, and recovery of every resident. All residents must read, understand, and sign this agreement prior to move-in.

1. SOBRIETY & RECOVERY REQUIREMENTS

- **Sobriety Requirement:** All residents must have a minimum of 30 days of continuous sobriety at admission. 45 days preferred.
- **Zero Tolerance:** Zero tolerance for drugs and alcohol on or off the premises. Any use results in immediate discharge.
- **Drug Testing:** Residents are subject to random 12-panel drug and alcohol testing at any time without advance notice. Refusal is treated as a positive result and grounds for immediate discharge.
- **Recovery Meetings:** Minimum 3 recovery meetings per week (AA, NA, or SMART Recovery). Meeting slips required.
- **Sponsor:** An active sponsor is required prior to move-in.
- **Medications:** All medications including MAT (Suboxone, Vivitrol, Methadone) must be disclosed at intake and stored in the house lockbox. Self-administration only. No sharing of medications under any circumstances.

2. RENT & FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Weekly Rent:** Weekly rent is due every Sunday by 6:00 PM.
- **Monthly Rent:** Monthly rent is due on the 1st of each month.
- **Late Warning:** If rent is not received by the due date a written warning will be sent by text message on Monday (weekly) or the 2nd of the month (monthly).
- **Discharge Timeline:** If rent remains unpaid by Wednesday (weekly) or the 5th of the month (monthly) the discharge process begins.
- **Employment:** Employment or a verified income source is required at move-in. Acceptable sources include employment, SSI, SSDI, disability, or family support.
- **Security Deposit:** The security deposit is non-refundable if a resident is discharged for rule violations.

3. CURFEW & CONDUCT

- **Curfew:** Sunday through Thursday: 10:00 PM. Friday and Saturday: 11:00 PM.
- **Guests:** No guests are permitted during the first 60 days of residency. This includes family members. After 60 days guests may be permitted with prior approval from the Residential Coordinator during approved hours only. No overnight guests under any circumstances. The Residential Coordinator reserves the right to deny any guest for any reason.
- **No Congregating in Front:** Residents may not gather or lounge in the front yard driveway or street-facing areas of the home. The backyard is available for outdoor relaxation.
- **No Violence:** No violence threats intimidation or verbal abuse toward any resident or staff. Violation results in immediate discharge.
- **No Weapons:** No weapons of any kind on the premises including firearms knives or any object used as a weapon.
- **No Gambling:** No gambling on the premises.
- **Relationships:** No romantic or sexual relationships between residents.
- **Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. No loud music TV or disturbances during quiet hours.

4. HOUSE RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Chores:** Each resident is assigned weekly chores. Chores must be completed before leaving the house each morning.
- **Room Cleanliness:** Rooms must be kept clean at all times. Room inspections are conducted every Sunday.
- **Kitchen:** No food or drinks in bedrooms. Kitchen and common areas must be cleaned immediately after use.
- **No Smoking:** No smoking inside the home. Smoking is permitted in the designated outdoor area only.
- **No Pets:** No pets. Service animals permitted with proper documentation provided at intake.
- **House Meeting:** Attendance at the Sunday 6:00 PM house meeting is mandatory for all residents.
- **Property:** Residents are responsible for any damage to their room or common areas beyond normal wear and tear.

5. IMMEDIATE DISCHARGE OFFENSES

The following offenses result in immediate discharge without refund of security deposit:

- Any drug or alcohol use on or off the premises
- Violence or threats against any person
- Possession of weapons of any kind
- Theft from any resident or the house
- Bringing drugs alcohol or weapons onto the premises
- Refusal to submit to drug or alcohol testing

6. GRIEVANCE POLICY

Every resident has the right to file a grievance without fear of retaliation. Grievances may be submitted verbally or in writing to the Residential Coordinator or Operator. If unresolved residents may contact GARR at (404) 719-1218 or thegarnetwork.org.

7. RIGHT TO MODIFY RULES

Crestridge Recovery House reserves the right to modify add or remove rules at any time. Residents will be notified of changes in writing with reasonable notice. Continued residency constitutes acceptance of updated rules.
